Policy Title: Spectator Entrance Fees

I - GENERAL

The NSCA has adopted the following guidelines with respect to host clubs charging an entrance fee to spectators during NSCA Championship events:

- Hosting clubs may charge a general admission fee to spectators while hosting an NSCA event
- The sole discretion of charging a fee will remain in the hands of the hosting club for an event held in their club
- Fee structures must be submitted to the NSCA for approval fifteen (15) days prior to the start of the event
- Fees must be approved by the NSCA Executive Director and/or the NSCA Championship Liaison prior to the fees being charged
- A report on the total amount of fees collected must be included in the final report submitted to the NSCA upon conclusion of the event
- All fees collected by the host club shall remain with the host club up to the amount of the hosting grant. Any funds collected by the club that exceed the hosting grant will be shared equally between the host club and the NSCA. The amount forwarded to the NSCA will be applied against the cost of hosting grants for the following year. These figures are net of HST

II – EXCLUSIONS

The following individuals/groups are exempt from paying Entrance Fees:

- Accredited media representatives
- Employees of the NSCA or the CCA
- Members of the Executive and/or the Board of Directors of the NSCA or the CCA
- Volunteers for the specific event
- Officials of the event
- Other special guests as determined by of the Host Committee for the Championship Event
